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We've been alerted that some members are receiving text messages that look like they're from APGFCU - but they're not. These messages often include a link asking you to take action.

Here's how to spot the red flags:

- ❌ Misspellings or awkward phrasing
- ❌ Pressure to act fast (scammers don't want you to pause and think)
- ❌ Links that don't lead to apgfcu.com

If something feels off, trust that instinct. Skip the link and go directly to apgfcu.com or use the official APGFCU app to access your account.

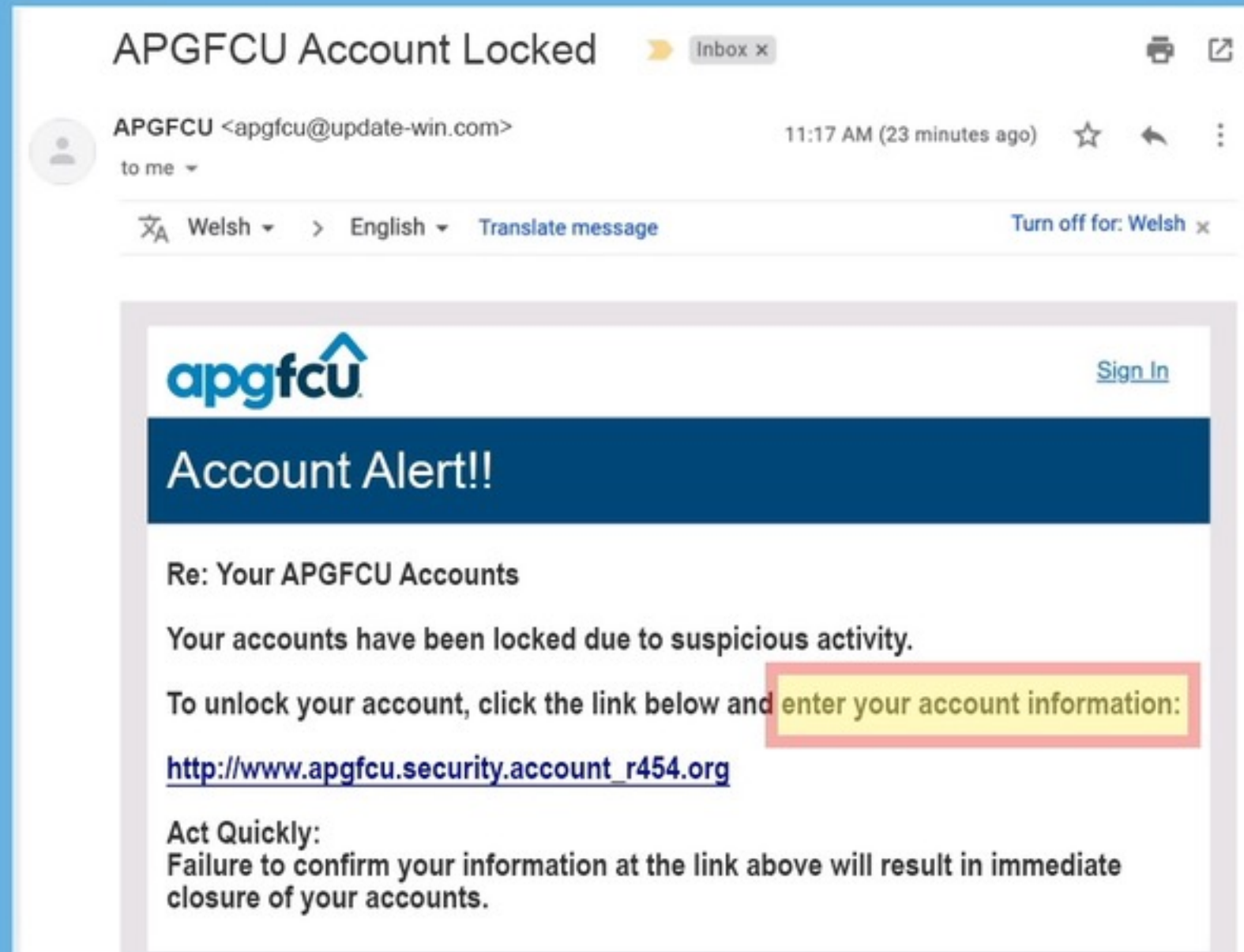
